

Questions raised by the Hon. Dennis Kwok regarding Agenda Item V of Panel on Security Meeting on 10 July 2018:

(1) Whether the police involved in the corresponding law enforcement actions to combat illegal prostitution activities over the past 5 years had undertaken training in human trafficking.

(2) Of the persons arrested for being suspected of taking up unlawful employment involving sex work in the past five years, as referenced in Annex III, how many were prosecuted and how many were convicted and what was their sentence range?

(3) Whether TIP screening mechanism was consistently applied to the persons referred to in Annex II and III, and whether any of those persons were identified as potential victims of trafficking. If so, how many and were they subject to a full debriefing and referred to relevant protection and supports?

(4) What are the procedure, time frame, living and repatriation arrangement for someone after being identified as a victim of sex trafficking?
