Note 1 : The number of places to be provided is a preliminary estimate and is subject to change as we continue to work out the details of the projects. For RCS places, both subsidised and non-subsidised places are included. Besides, the services provided by NECs are open to all elderly persons aged 60 or above residing in the respective Districts, and there is no limit on the number of members.

Note 2 : This is a re-provisioning project for an existing 22-place DCU attached to a District Elderly Community Centre in Tuen Mun to expand to a 60-place DE.
