Further to our reply letter dated 10 January 2019，in accordance with the information provided by Social Welfare Department（SWD），we provide a reply to remaining Questions（1）to（3）of the letter below．

Moreover, the area of day care units for the elderly (DCUs) (if applicable) provided at individual homes is also included in the figures.
