**Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to
the Central Military Dock**

It is noted that an application for leave to apply for judicial review against the decision of the Chief Executive in Council to approve the relevant Amended Draft Outline Zoning Plan of the Central District ("Judicial Review") has been filed by a member of the public. Following the meeting of the Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to the Central Military Dock ("Subcommittee") held on 21 May 2019, the Subcommittee has received a letter from the Solicitors for the Applicant in the Judicial Review stating that the Orders and Regulations governing the handover of the Central Military Dock ("CMD") to the Garrison pertain directly to the subject matter of the Judicial Review and requesting the Subcommittee to withhold from discussing, deciding upon, or otherwise taking steps to further the subsidiary legislative work concerning the CMD pending the outcome of the Judicial Review so as to preserve the *status quo* and properly allow the courts of Hong Kong to arrive at a determination on this matter.

On the instructions of Hon WONG Ting-kwong, Chairman of the Subcommittee, to facilitate the Subcommittee to properly consider the matter,

the Administration is asked to provide the Subcommittee with the following information:

- (a) the status of the Judicial Review proceedings; and
- (b) whether the Judicial Review, including the relief sought by the Applicant, would in any way affect the work of the Subcommittee.

We would appreciate it if you could let us have the information in both Chinese and English as soon as practicable, preferably by noon, 27 May 2019.
