#### I. Election of Chairman

#### Election of Chairman

Mr WONG Ting-kwong, the member of the highest precedence among those present at the meeting, presided over the election of Chairman. He invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Subcommittee.

  - (b) impact of declining inbound visitors and outbound travellers on the financial arrangements of the Travel Industry Authority ("TIA") and the counter measures to be adopted by the Administration to avoid a significant increase in TIA levies or licence fees; and
  - (c) latest progress and timeline for TIA to commence full operation.

#### <u>Invitation of deputations' views</u>

7. <u>Members</u> considered it not necessary for the Subcommittee to invite public views on the subsidiary legislation.
