**Panel on Information Technology and Broadcasting
Re-provision of Offices and Production Facilities of
Radio Television Hong Kong in the InnoCentre and the Educational
Television Centre, and the New Broadcasting House Project**

Thank you for your email of 14 May 2020 to the Commerce and Economic Development Bureau (CEDB), which enclosed a letter from the Hon. Alvin YEUNG requesting information on the offices and production facilities of Radio Television Hong Kong (RTHK) and the New Broadcasting House (New BH) Project. CEDB has referred the request to RTHK for a direct reply. Having consulted the Education Bureau and the Innovation and Technology Bureau, I am authorised to reply as follows:

Re-provision of Offices and Production Facilities in the InnoCentre and the Educational Television Centre

On the issues raised in the Member's letter, CEDB has made a written reply on 27 May 2020 to Question No. 16 of the Legislative Council Meeting.

New BH Project

RTHK has been actively taking forward the New BH project. With the assistance of the Architectural Services Department, RTHK is currently negotiating with several departments which have indicated their interest in the joint-user building on their respective requirements, as well as project design and planning. RTHK will continue to take forward the New BH project in accordance with the established mechanism.

Meanwhile, RTHK will continue to strengthen the maintenance and repair as well as implement temporary measures to improve the facilities and working environment of the existing RTHK premises at the Broadcast Drive, in order to enhance the level of public broadcasting.
