

NOTE FOR PUBLIC WORKS SUBCOMMITTEE OF FINANCE COMMITTEE

Forecast of submissions for the 2020-21 Legislative Council session

This note gives an overview of the potential capital works items to be submitted to the Public Works Subcommittee (PWSC) in the 2020-21 Legislative Council (LegCo) session.

2. On the basis of the latest advice of bureaux and departments, a total of 91¹ projects, as listed in **Enclosure 1**, may be ready for submission to the PWSC before the 2021 summer recess. To enable Members to have a better understanding of the projects, we have provided supplementary information on each project at **Enclosure 2** following the same order presented in **Enclosure 1**. The list is our best projection at this stage and is subject to refinements.

3. The Government will try to adhere to the target dates as set out in **Enclosures 1** and **2** as much as possible. However, there may be programme changes arising from statutory gazettal and objections from the consultation phase as well as due to the necessary variations to the design for individual projects. We will account for deviations from the current forecast in a year-end report for Members' reference.

4. We apply price adjustment factors for deriving the cost estimate of capital works projects funded by the Capital Works Reserve Fund in money-of-the-day prices. The updated prices of public sector building and construction output are assumed to increase by 3.0% for 2020, 5% per annum from 2021 to 2025, 4.5% per annum from 2026 to 2028 and 4% per annum from 2029 to 2030. Price adjustment factors used in funding applications regarding capital works projects are updated annually.

Project Code and Title: 5767CL—Planning and engineering study for Lung Kwu Tan reclamation and the re-planning of Tuen Mun West area

Policy Bureau and Branch: Development Bureau (Works Branch)

Works Department: Civil Engineering and Development Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is to conduct studies for Lung Kwu Tan reclamation and the re-planning of Tuen Mun West Area. The scope of the project comprises (a) a planning and engineering study for the proposed Lung Kwu Tan reclamation and the re-planning of Tuen Mun West area to establish the reclamation extent, land uses and development proposals, as well as undertaking the relevant detailed impact assessments, including statutory environmental impact assessment and area-wide traffic impact assessment, and preliminary design of associated infrastructure including upgrading of Lung Mun Road; (b) community engagement and consultation exercises with the stakeholders; and (c) associated site investigation works including supervision. The project is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2021–Q3 for completion in 30 months.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Below \$200 million

Target Contract Start Date: 2021–Q3

Previous or planned panel consultation: The Panel on Development was consulted on 20 January 2020. Members generally supported submitting the funding proposal to the Public Works Sub-committee (PWSC) for consideration. Due to insufficient time at the last PWSC meeting in the last Legislative Council session on 24 June 2020, the item was not dealt with.

Project Code and Title: 5782CL—Engineering study on Road P1 (Tai Ho–Sunny Bay Section)

Policy Bureau and Branch: Development Bureau (Works Branch)

Works Department: Civil Engineering and Development Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is to conduct study on the proposed strategic Road P1 from Tai Ho Interchange to Sunny Bay to alleviate the anticipated traffic congestion in North Lantau. The proposed scope of the project comprises (a) an investigation study and the preliminary design for the works relating to the Road P1 (Tai Ho – Sunny Bay Section) that mainly consists of the following works components – (i) a carriageway that extends from the Tai Ho Interchange to Sunny Bay and connects to the North Lantau Highway and the proposed Route 11; and (ii) the associated building, civil, structural, marine, electrical and mechanical, landscaping, and environmental protection and mitigation works; and (b) the associated site investigation works and works supervision.

We plan to commence the study upon obtaining funding approval from the Finance Committee for target completion in about 30 months.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Below \$200 million

Previous or planned panel consultation: The Panel on Development was consulted on the proposed works on 20 January 2020. Members generally supported submitting the funding proposal to the PWSC for consideration. Due to insufficient time at the last PWSC meeting in the last Legislative Council session on 24 June 2020, the item was not dealt with.

Project Code and Title: 5049CG—The District Cooling System for Tung Chung New Town Extension (East)

Policy Bureau and Branch: Environment Bureau

Works Department: Electrical and Mechanical Services Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for implementing a District Cooling System (DCS) at Tung Chung New Town Extension (East). The proposed scope of the project comprises (a) a chiller plant cum seawater pump house; (b) seawater pipes; (c) chilled water distribution pipes; and (d) connection facilities at user buildings. To tie in with the infrastructure works, we plan to commence construction of the proposed works by phases upon obtaining funding approval from the Finance Committee, for substantial completion of the main works of the DCS in about nine years.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Above \$500 million

Target Contract Start Date: 2021–Q2

Previous or planned panel consultation: We consulted the Panel on Development on 24 November 2020. The Panel supported the submission of the proposal to the PWSC for consideration.

Project Code and Title: 7786CL—Tung Chung New Town Extension

Policy Bureau and Branch: Development Bureau (Planning and Lands Branch)

Works Department: Civil Engineering and Development Department

Project Description:

The part of the project proposed for upgrading to Category A is for the site formation and construction of engineering infrastructure for Tung Chung New Town Extension. The proposed scope of the project comprises –

(a) site formation of land about 6 hectares of land for public housing development in Tung Chung West (TCW); (b) construction of dual two-lane Road P1 (Tung Chung – Tai Ho Section) of about 2.5 kilometres (km) long, Tai Ho Interchange (including slip roads), roads of about 10 km long, footpaths of about 22 km long, and cycle tracks of about 11 km long in TCNTE, and associated junction/ road improvement works; (c) engineering infrastructure works covering drainage, sewerage (including upgrading of the existing Chung Mun Road Sewage Pumping Station and construction of three new sewage pumping stations), waterworks (including a fresh water service reservoir, a salt water service reservoir and a salt water pumping station), common utility tunnels and landscaping works; (d) construction of the first phase of River Park including a visitor centre at TCW; (e) construction of proposed open space in Area 29A in TCW; (f) construction of sustainable urban drainage system in TCW; and (g) implementation of environmental mitigation measures and environmental monitoring and audit programme for the works mentioned in items (a) to (f) above.

We plan to commence the proposed works upon obtaining funding approval from the Finance Committee for target completion in about seven years, with phased completion expected from 2024 onwards.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Above \$500 million

Previous or planned panel consultation: The Panel on Development was consulted on the proposed works on 24 November 2020. Members supported the submission of the funding application of the proposed works to the PWSC for consideration.

Project Code and Title: 3470RO—Lung Tsun Stone Bridge Preservation Corridor at Kai Tak

Policy Bureau and Branch: Development Bureau (Works Branch)

Works Department: Architectural Services Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the construction of a preservation corridor for in-situ preservation and public appreciation of the Lung Tsun Stone Bridge (LTSB) remnants. The proposed scope of the project comprises (a) in-situ preservation of the LTSB remnants and the construction of a preservation corridor for public appreciation and leisure purpose; and (b) improvement of the walkway within Shek Ku Lung Road Playground that heads to the Kowloon Walled City Park. The construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2021–Q2 for completion in 2025–Q2.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Above \$500 million

Target Contract Start Date: 2021–Q2

Previous or planned panel consultation: We consulted the Panel on Development on the proposed works on 28 April 2020. Members did not object to the submission of the funding proposal to PWSC for consideration.

Project Code and Title: 4172CD—Rehabilitation of underground stormwater drains - remaining works

Policy Bureau and Branch: Development Bureau (Works Branch)

Works Department: Drainage Services Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the rehabilitation of the ageing underground stormwater drains in Central & Western District, Wan Chai District, Eastern District, Southern District, Islands District, Tuen Mun District, Yuen Long District, North District, Tai Po District, Sha Tin District, Kwun Tong District and Sai Kung District (the 12 Districts). The proposed scope of the project comprises (a) rehabilitation of a total of about 19 kilometres of underground stormwater drains and the associated manholes in the 12 Districts and (b) ancillary works. We plan to commence the proposed works upon obtaining funding approval from the Finance Committee for target completion of the works in around five years.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Above \$500 million

Target Contract Start Date: 2021–Q2

Previous or planned panel consultation: We consulted the Panel on Development on the proposed works on 24 November 2020. Members supported the submission of the funding proposal to the PWSC for consideration.

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the construction of a covered four-span footbridge system at the junction of Sham Mong Road and Yen Chow Street West in Sham Shui Po. The construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2021–Q2/Q3 for completion in 4 years.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): \$200 million - \$500 million

The proposed project is for the improvement of salt water supply to Tsuen Wan and Kwai Chung.
