Follow-up Issues Arising from the Meeting on 16 June 2021**

**Site Formation and Associated Infrastructural Works for  
Development of Columbarium at Siu Ho Wan on Lantau Island  
(841CL)**

At the request of Members at the Public Works Subcommittee meeting held on 16 June 2021, the Government provides relevant information as follows:

2. During Ching Ming and Chung Yeung Festivals, the Administration will appeal to the public to go to the columbarium at Siu Ho Wan by public transport as far as possible.
3. Drivers who need park and ride facilities may park their vehicles in the public car park next to MTR Sunny Bay Station, and take the specially-arranged buses that depart from MTR Sunny Bay Station (with the peak frequency of 5 buses in a 6-minute interval) to the columbarium at Siu Ho Wan.
4. The Administration will hold inter-departmental meetings before Ching Ming and Chung Yeung Festivals to discuss the deployment of traffic arrangements, and will monitor the utilisation of the above-mentioned public car park during those Festival periods. Drivers may also park their vehicles in the car park at the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Boundary Crossing Facilities, and then go to MTR Sunny Bay Station by public transport, and subsequently take the above-mentioned specially-arranged buses to the columbarium at Siu Ho Wan. We have relayed Members' views to the department concerned, and will keep in view the actual situation after commissioning of the columbarium and make adjustments to the traffic arrangements if needed.
