**I. Meeting with the Administration**

(File Ref: TsyB MA 00/625-1/2/0 (C) Pt. 40, L.N.170 to L.N. 172 of 2020, L.N.192 to L.N. 193 of 2020, LC Paper No. LS125/19-20 and LC Paper Nos. CB(4)83/20-21(01) – (05))

The Subcommittee deliberated and examined the following five pieces of subsidiary legislation on fee waiving or concession measures to support the transport sector ("the five pieces of subsidiary legislation") (index of proceedings is at **Annex**):

- (a) the Road Traffic (Registration and Licensing of Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulation 2020 (L.N.170 of 2020);
- (b) the Road Traffic (Registration and Licensing of Vehicles) (Amendment) (Fee Concessions) Regulation 2019 (Amendment) Regulation 2020 (L.N.171 of 2020);
- (c) the Road Traffic Ordinance (Amendment of Schedule 3) Order 2020 (L.N.172 of 2020);
- (d) the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulation 2020 (L.N.192 of 2020); and

- (e) the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) (Amendment) (Fee Concessions) Regulation 2019 (Amendment) Regulation 2020 (L.N.193 of 2020).

2. Members noted that as agreed at the meeting on 2 November 2020, public views on the five pieces of subsidiary legislation were invited. No submission had been received.

3. The Chairman concluded that the Subcommittee had completed the scrutiny of the five pieces of subsidiary legislation. Members noted that the Chairman would move a resolution at the Council meeting of 11 November 2020 to extend the scrutiny period of the five pieces of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 2 December 2020. Subject to the extension of the scrutiny period, the deadline for giving notice of amendments to the five pieces of subsidiary legislation would be 25 November 2020. Members also noted that the Subcommittee would submit its report to the House Committee on 20 November 2020.

*(Post-meeting note: the Chairman's proposed resolution to extend the scrutiny period of the five pieces of subsidiary legislation was not dealt with before adjournment of the Council meeting of 11 November 2020. The scrutiny period of the five pieces of subsidiary legislation therefore expired at the said Council meeting.)*
