The Administration was expediting the redaction of commercially sensitive information so as to make the redacted consultancy report available to members for reading as soon as possible.</p> <p>At the policy briefing on 29 October 2019, the Administration advised that it would discuss with the Airport Authority the Phase Two expansion of AsiaWorld-Expo. Besides, the sites of three government towers in Wan Chai</p>

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				<p>North and Kong Wan Fire Station were expected to be vacated by 2026 at the earliest for demolition and redevelopment into convention and exhibition facilities, hotel and office.</p> <p>The Administration will brief the Panel on the development of convention and exhibition industry in Hong Kong in the second quarter of 2021.</p>
