Progress Report on the Implementation of the Construction Innovation and Technology Fund

Follow-up Action to the Meeting on 22 June 2021

In response to the request of the Panel at the meeting on 22 June 2021, we provide supplementary information in relation to the "Progress Report on the Implementation of the Construction Innovation and Technology Fund" as below -

(a) a breakdown of the about 60 public projects in the pipeline using the Modular Integrated Construction ("MiC") method by category of projects (e.g. public housing projects and redevelopment projects of old districts)

Since April 2020, Modular Integration Construction ("MiC") should be adopted for specified building works under the Capital Works Programme, such as schools, hostels, hospitals and office buildings. At present, about 60 projects of the Government, public organisations and non-governmental organisations in which MiC will be adopted are under planning, design or construction stage. These include 21 hostel related projects, 12 community health centre and hospital projects, 8 school projects, 4 urban renewal and Housing Society projects, 3 public housing development projects, and more than 10 other construction projects including government office buildings, transitional housing, etc.

(b) a breakdown of the number of applicants granted with the CITF funds and the grant amount (including separate figures for small- and medium-sized enterprises) by category (i.e. Building Information Modelling ("BIM") training, BIM adoption, Advanced Construction Technology, MiC, Prefabricated Steel Bar and Manpower Development) as of 31 May 2021
