A letter to the Bills Committee on Legislative Council (Amendment) Bill 1999

Dear members of the Bills Committee,

The Hong Kong (Cross Border) Transportation Drivers' Association (CBDA) is deeply disappointed that our Association is not listed as one of the electors of the Transport Functional Constituency under the Legislative Council (Amendment) Bill 1999. Therefore, we are writing to express our views, in the hope that the CBDA can be included in the list of electors for the Transport Functional Constituency.

Founded in July 1998, the CBDA is registered under the Societies Ordinance. At present, the CBDA has about 700 members who are all individual members. Our objective is to strive for the rights and welfare that drivers are entitled to.

Some of the executive members of the CBDA are former executive members of the Organization of Hong Kong Drivers which is an elector of the Transport Functional Constituency. They include LO Yik-charn (Chairman of CBDA), LEUNG Kai-wai (Honorary Secretary), CHAN Ngai-wing (Executive Member) etc.

We hold the view that the CBDA is qualified to be an elector of the Transport Functional Constituency. We hope that you will consider our views carefully.
