Supplementary Information on 496CL – Advance engineering infrastructure works for Pak Shek Kok development

INTRODUCTION

When Members considered paper PWSC(1999-2000)23 on **496CL** at the PWSC meeting held on 26 May 1999, we undertook to provide supplementary information on the details of jobs that would be created upon the completion of the Science Park phase 1 works and the full development at Pak Shek Kok.

THE ADMINSTRATION'S RESPONSE

2. We estimate that with the opening of the Science Park phase 1 in late 2001, about 5 500 jobs will be created. Upon the full development at Pak Shek Kok in 2016, some 20 000 jobs will be created. The anticipated employment mix would be as follows –
