#(1)李永達議員（口頭答覆）

政府可否告知本會：

- (a) 在審批持有“回美紙”及中國護照的人士所提出的入境簽證申請方面，入境事務處採取的政策及準則為何；
- (b) 入境事務處為何於上月拒絕 11 名持有“回美紙”及中國護照並計劃來港出席國際研討會的人士所提出的入境簽證申請；該處在作出有關決定時，有否考慮拒絕讓該等人士來港對香港的國際形象會否產生負面影響；及
- (b) 香港在回歸前的入境政策與回歸後的入境政策是否一致；若然，該 11 名人士當中曾於香港回歸前獲准入境的人士，為何現在被入境事務處拒絕發出入境簽證；若否，詳情為何？

(1) Hon LEE Wing-tat (Oral Reply)

Will the Government inform this Council:

- (a) of the policies and criteria adopted by the Immigration Department ("ID") for processing entry visa applications from the holders of "US re-entry permits" and Chinese passports;
- (b) of the reasons for the ID's rejection last month of the entry visa applications by 11 holders of "US re-entry permits" and Chinese passports, who had planned to attend an international seminar in Hong Kong; and whether, in making such a decision, the ID has considered if the refusal of these persons' entry into Hong Kong would produce any negative effects on the image of Hong Kong internationally; and
- (c) whether the entry policies of Hong Kong before and after the reunification with China are consistent; if so, why some of the 11 persons in question who had been allowed entry into Hong Kong before the reunification are now denied entry visas by the ID; if not, the details of that?
