Import and Export (Removal of Articles)
(Amendment) Regulation 1998 (L.N. 370 of 1998)

Thank you for your letter of 21 December 1998. The arrangement for ensuring that the faxed notice has been received by the intended recipient is set out below.

The intended recipient of the faxed notice will be required to acknowledge receipt of the notice by returning a form attached to the notice, also by fax. Customs officers will check the record of acknowledgment at hourly intervals. If no acknowledgment is received, Customs officers will contact the intended recipient by telephone and request him/her to confirm the receipt of notice by faxing the acknowledgment form back to Customs. If the acknowledgment cannot be obtained after repeated attempts, Customs officers will serve the notice in person.
