Re: Factories and Industrial Undertakings (Medical Examinations) Regulation

We refer to your letter of 9 March 2000 and would like to express the disagreement of the HKCA to the proposed new subsection (3) under section 12 of the proposed Regulation. Our comments are as follows:

- 1. Vacancy may not be available. If there was, the vacancy may require different skills that the concerned worker may not possess or he/she is unqualified to take up.
- 2. Higher risk to the concerned worker and his/her co-workers. Taking up new job needs adoption to new requirements and environment, which may expose the concerned worker to safety and health hazard.
- 3. Causing conflicts in employee relations. If the re-deployed job is of lower remuneration the concerned worker ma not accept it. It will cause unnecessary tension between the concerned worker and his/her employer. Clarification should be sought that deployment to a lower paid job is not a breach to Employment Ordinance by the employer.
