- 1. Service quality
 - how to ensure and improve the quality of health care service in particular service provided by the private sector
 - how to monitor and improve cost-effectiveness of health care service
 - public sector (Hospital Authority, Department of Health, non-government organizations)
 - private sector (private hospitals/ clinics/ health care centres)
 - how to provide appropriate information for patients to make informed choices on hospitals, physicians, drugs and treatments
 - drug prescription
 - fees charged
 - drug labelling
 - regulation of medical professionals
- 2. Coordination between different health care structures
 - primary health care and inpatient care
 - acute medicine and community medicine
 - private and public services
 - the balance between hospital-based services and primary health care services
- 3. Health care financing
 - can the existing system be sustained
 - the direction of future reform
