port control (public cargo
working area) order 1999

(Made under section 3(1) of the Port Control (Cargo
Working Areas) Ordinance (Cap. 81))

1. Commencement

This Order shall come into operation on 18 January 1999.

2. Public cargo working area

That portion of the area of unleased Government land situated at Stonecutters Island (having an area of approximately 22 700 square metres) delineated and coloured pink on the plan numbered DM50 signed by the Deputy Director of Lands (Survey and Mapping) on behalf of the Director of Lands on 27 October 1998, and deposited in the Tsuen Wan New Territories Land Registry, is declared to be a public cargo working area.

3. Repeal

The Port Control (Public Cargo Working Area) (No. 3) Order 1998 (L. N. 56 of 1998) is repealed.

4. Paragraphs repealed and added

The Port Control (Public Cargo Working Area) (Consolidation) Order (Cap. 81 sub. leg.) is amended---

(a) by repealing paragraph 4;

(b) by adding---

"12. Stonecutters Island public cargo working area

That portion of the area of unleased Government land situated at Stonecutters Island (having an area of approximately 22 700 square metres) delineated and coloured pink on the plan numbered DM50 signed by the Deputy Director of Lands (Survey and Mapping) on behalf of the Director of Lands on 27 October 1998, and deposited in the Tsuen Wan New Territories Land Registry, is declared to be a public cargo working area. "
