Regulation 1999

(Made under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537) by the Chief Executive on the instruction of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China and after consultation with the Executive Council)

1. Suspension of Regulation

The operation of the United Nations Sanctions (Libya) (Prohibition of Flights) Regulation (Cap. 537 sub. leg.) is hereby suspended.

Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Regulation is to suspend the operation of the United Nations Sanctions (Libya) (Prohibition of Flights) Regulation (Cap. 537 sub. leg.). The Security Council of the United Nations has suspended the sanctions against Libya and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China has instructed the Chief Executive to suspend the operation of the above Regulation in accordance with section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537).
