DESIGNATION OF MUSEUMS (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1998

(Made by the Provisional Urban Council under section 105G of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

1. Designation of building as a museum

The building located at 100 Chatham Road South, Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon and known as the Hong Kong Museum of History is designated as a museum.

2. Building ceased to be designated

as a museum

The building located at Blocks S61 and S62, Kowloon Park, Haiphong Road, Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon shall cease to be designated as a museum.

3. Schedule amended

The list of museums under the heading "Urban Council Area" in the Schedule to the Designation of Museums Order (Cap. 132 sub. leg.) is amended by repealing "The Hong Kong Museum of History, Blocks S61 and S62 and 58, Kowloon Park, Haiphong Road." and substituting---

"The Hong Kong Museum of History, Block 58, Kowloon Park, Haiphong Road, Tsim Sha Tsui.
