

Bills Committee on Entertainment Special Effects Bill

Special Effects Materials List

At the meeting on 12 May 2000, we undertook to the Bills Committee to provide a list of the special effects materials which will be included in the Special Effects Materials List to be prescribed in the regulation to be made under the Entertainment Special Effects Bill. These materials are set out below for Members' information.

A. Pyrotechnic Special Effects Materials

<u>Item</u>	<u>Description</u>
1.	Lifters
2.	Soft detonators
3.	Special effects detonating cords
4.	Special effects shaped charges
5.	Pre-assembled pyrotechnic special effects devices including cable cutters and explosive bolts
6.	Sparking granules and similar devices
7.	Simulated phosphorus and similar devices
8.	Black powder composition charges and devices
9.	Smokeless powder charges and devices
10.	Trail powder charges and devices
11.	Two component (or Binary) flash powder composition charges and devices
12.	Nitrated cellulose including flash paper, flash cotton, flash string
13.	Smoke composition charges and devices including smoke

cookies, smoke granules, smoke pellets, smoke candles, smoke pots, smoke signals and smoke grenades

14. Pyrotechnic fuses including Visco fuses, quick matches, black matches, arcing matches and silver matches
15. Igniter cords
16. Electric matches
17. Squibs
18. Igniters
19. Special effects shock tubing
20. Bullet hits
21. Other materials which are designed to produce heat, light, sound, gas, smoke or a combination of these effects as a result of a self-sustaining and self-contained exothermic chemical reaction by combustion, deflagration or detonation

B. Non-Pyrotechnic Special Effects Materials

<u>Item</u>	<u>Description</u>
1.	Liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) within the meaning of the Gas Safety Ordinance (Cap. 51)
2.	Dangerous goods other than those in Category 1 of the Schedule to the Dangerous Goods (Application and Exemption) Regulations (Cap. 295 sub. leg.)
3.	Anthracene
4.	Lycopodium
