**Managing Indoor Air Quality in Hong Kong  
Public Consultation**

**Purpose**

This paper seeks Members' views on the proposed indoor air quality (IAQ) management programme.

**Background**

2. Members were briefed on 8 January 1999 about the findings and recommendations of the consultancy study on "Indoor Air Pollution in Offices and Public Places". Taking into account comments made by Members and others in the community, we have prepared a proposed IAQ management programme. This has recently been put out for consultation with professional bodies and the public.

**Indoor Air Quality Management**

3. The proposed IAQ management programme will start with a publicity campaign to raise public awareness of IAQ and an IAQ Information Centre will also be set up in 2000 for disseminating IAQ information. The Government will take the lead in implementing an IAQ certification programme for selected government buildings in 2000. In parallel, private owners and building management will be invited to participate in the certification programme. Three years after the implementation of the certification programme, i.e. in 2003, we will review the position and consider the need to broaden the scope and to make annual certification a compulsory requirement.

4. To help building owners and management evaluate and manage indoor air quality, we have prepared a set of recommended air quality objectives as well as a set of technical guidance notes for the better management of IAQ.

## **Consultation**

5. We commenced consultation on this proposal with various professional bodies in August 1999. A wider public consultation on the programme was launched in early November 1999 and ended on 31 December 1999. The proposed programme will be further refined to respond to public aspirations. A consultation paper on “Managing Indoor Air Quality” and a set of Guidance Notes for better management of IAQ in offices and public places were circulated for Members’ reference on 5 November 1999.

## **Advice Sought**

6. Members are invited to comment on the consultation package for improving IAQ in Hong Kong. Our intention is to take into account all the views expressed in the consultation exercise before finalising our proposal in early 2000.
