## **I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman**

In accordance with Rule 77(5) of the Rules of Procedures, Mr YEUNG Yiu-chung called for nominations for the Chairmanship of the Panel.

2. Mr YEUNG Yiu-chung was nominated by Miss CHOY So-yuk and the nomination was seconded by Mr TSANG Yuk-shing. Mr YEUNG accepted the nomination. There being no other nomination, Mr NG Ching-fai, the presiding Member, declared that Mr YEUNG Yiu-chung was elected as Chairman of the Panel.

3. Mr YEUNG Yiu-chung took the chair and called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel.

4. Miss CHOY So-yuk nominated Prof NG Ching-fai as Deputy Chairman of the Panel and the nomination was seconded by Mr TSANG Yuk-shing. Prof NG Ching-fai accepted the nomination. There being no other nomination, the Chairman declared that Prof NG Ching-fai was elected as Deputy Chairman of the Panel.

## **II. Schedule of meetings for the session 1999-2000**

5. Members agreed to hold the next meeting on 26 October 1999. Subsequent regular meetings would be held at 4:30 pm on the third Monday of each month.

## **III. Discussion items for the next meeting**

6. Miss Emily LAU proposed a joint meeting with the Panel on Home Affairs to discuss the Report of the Equal Opportunities Commission on the Secondary School Places Allocation System. She was concerned that there might be sex discrimination against female students under the current system for allocation of secondary school places. Miss CHOY So-yuk, Chairman of the Panel on Home Affairs, indicated agreement to the proposal. After discussion, members agreed to hold a joint meeting with the Home Affairs Panel at 10:45 am on 26 October 1999.

7. Referring to the list of issues suggested for discussion (Appendix V of LC Paper No. CB(2)10/99-00), members agreed to discuss the Education Commission's consultation document on Review of Education System-Framework for Education Reform on 26 October 1999 at 11:45 am, immediately after the joint

meeting with the Panel on Home Affairs.

*(Post-meeting note : Discussion of the item was subsequently deferred to the meeting scheduled for 15 November 1999.)*

8. The Chairman suggested and members agreed to discuss the employment situation of current year graduates of the Hong Kong Institute of Education at the November meeting.
