LegCo Panel on Education Y2K Compliance Exercise

I refer to your letter of 14.10.99, requesting a further report on systems for which Y2K validation lists and contingency plans are <u>still not completed</u>.

This Bureau submitted to the Panel on 9.9.1999 a Progress Report of Year 2000 Compliance Exercise in Government Departments Responsible for Education Matters and Non-government Organisations in the Education Field, which showed that, as at 15 August 1999, all except one mission-critical systems were confirmed to be Y2K compliant. I now write to confirm that as from 15 September 1999, all mission-critical computer and embedded systems in the relvant departments and non-government organisations (NGOs) have been confirmed to be Y2K compliant and contingency plans have been in place in all of these departments and NGOs.
