

**Investigation Panel on Staff Discipline
in Yuen Chau Kok and Tin Chung Court Incidents**

The Secretary for Housing, Mr Dominic S W Wong, has appointed Mr Stephen Selby as the Chairman of the Investigation Panel on Staff Discipline in the Yuen Chau Kok and Tin Chung Court Incidents. Mr Selby is currently the Director of Intellectual Property.

Also appointed to serve on the Panel are Mr Choy Kin-kuen, a Chief Structural Engineer of the Buildings Department, Ms Stephanie Chung, a Senior Architect from the Architectural Services Department and Mrs Wong Ma Wai-mei, a Principal Executive Officer who will be Secretary in addition.

"This four-member Panel will establish and collate evidence, if any, of misconduct to enable consideration of disciplinary proceedings against any staff member concerned in the Housing Department. The Panel will also identify specific acts of misconduct, if any, which warrant administrative or disciplinary action," said Mr Wong.

"There is a good mix of experience and professional knowledge on the Panel. As Members do not come from the Housing Department, I believe that they will conduct a fair and thorough investigation and make

an impartial judgement," Mr Wong added.

The Panel will start investigation soon. After completion of investigation, it will make recommendations to the Secretary for Housing on whether administrative or disciplinary action should be taken against any staff member in the Housing Department. Any such action will be taken in accordance with normal civil service practice.
