

LegCo Panel on Housing

Concerns raised by members at the special meeting on 14 December 1999 which require follow-up actions by the Administration

At the meeting on 14 December 1999, the Administration was requested to:

- explain the prevailing tendering system for public housing projects;
- advise the respective weightings between tender price and performance of contractors/consultants in the evaluation of tenders for different types of public works and public housing projects;
- advise the percentage of public works and public housing contracts which have not been awarded to the lowest tender over the past five years;
- advise the percentage of supervision cost, as opposed to the total project cost, which has been spent on public works and public housing projects; and
- provide a full report on the case in which a piling contractor was convicted of a fine of \$7,500 for shortened piles in 1998.
