

L.N. 191 of 2000

Optometrists (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) (Amendment) Regulation 2000
(Made by the Supplementary Medical Professions Council under
section 29(1B) of the Supplementary Medical Professions
Ordinance (Cap. 359) with the approval of
the Secretary for Health and Welfare)

1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on 1 July 2000.

2. Qualifications for registration

Section 4 of the Optometrists (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure)
Regulation (Cap. 359 sub. leg.) is amended by adding---

"(ca) a Certificate of Attainment in Ocular Pharmacology issued by the Hong Kong
Polytechnic University;"

3. Section added

The following is added---

"5A. Part II optometrists may be registered
as Part I optometrists

(1) Without affecting section 5(a) and (e), the Secretary shall, for the purposes
of section 13(4) of the Ordinance, enter the name of a Part II optometrist in Part
I of the register if that optometrist---

(a) holds a qualification referred to in section 4(ca); and

(b) has practised for one year or more after having been registered as a Part II
optometrist, or has other experience that is recognized by the Board for the purpose
of this section.

(2) In this section, "Part II optometrist" (第II部分視光師) means an optometrist
whose name has been entered in Part II of the register."
