PHARMACY AND POISONS (AMENDMENT)

(NO. 3) REGULATION 2000

(Made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board under section 29
of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138)
subject to the approval of the Legislative Council)

1. Substances falling within the Poisons List
to which special restrictions apply under
regulations 3 and 5

The First Schedule to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.)
is amended in part A---

(a) by repealing "Minoxidil" and substituting---

"Minoxidil except when contained in preparations intended for external application
only and the preparations contain not more than 5% of Minoxidil";

(b) by adding---

"Eprosartan; its salts
Leflunomide; its salts
Mizolastine; its salts
Oseltamivir; its salts
Palivizumab".

2. Substances required by regulation 9 to be sold
by retail only upon a prescription given
by a registered medical practitioner,
registered dentist or registered
veterinary surgeon

The Third Schedule is amended in part A---

(a) by repealing "Minoxidil" and substituting---

"Minoxidil except when contained in preparations intended for external application
only and the preparations contain not more than 5% of Minoxidil";

(b) by adding---

"Eprosartan; its salts
Leflunomide; its salts
Mizolastine; its salts
Oseltamivir; its salts
Palivizumab".

Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the First and Third Schedules to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.) to---

- (a) add 5 new substances to the First and Third Schedules respectively (sections 1(b) and 2(b));
- (b) relax the control over minoxidil contained in preparations intended for external application only and the preparations contain not more than 5% of minoxidil (sections 1(a) and 2(a)).
