Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Public Pleasure Grounds) (Amendment of

Fourth Schedule) (No. 8) Order 1999

(Made by the Provisional Regional Council under section 106

of the Public Health and Municipal Services

Ordinance (Cap. 132))

1. Places set aside as public pleasure grounds

The places specified in Schedule 1 are set aside for use as public pleasure grounds.

2. Places ceasing to be set aside as public pleasure grounds

The places specified in Schedule 2 cease to be set aside for use as public pleasure grounds.

3. Public pleasure grounds

The Fourth Schedule to the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) is amended to the extent specified in Schedule 3.
