

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE

**RESOLUTION**

(Under section 29 of the Pharmacy and  
Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138))

---

RESOLVED that the following Regulations, made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board on 5  
April 2000, be approved -

- (a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) (No. 2)  
Regulation 2000; and
- (b) the Poisons List (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulation 2000.

**POISONS LIST (AMENDMENT)(NO. 2) REGULATION 2000**

(Made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board under section  
29 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance  
(Cap. 138) subject to the approval of  
the Legislative Council)

**1. Commencement**

Section 2(a)(ii) and (b) shall come into operation on 10 July 2000.

**2. The Poisons List**

The Schedule to the Poisons List Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.) is amended –

(a) in Part I, in part A –

(i) by adding –

"Abacavir; its salts  
Amisulpride; its salts  
Capecitabine; its salts  
Daclizumab  
Eptifibatide; its salts  
Nelfinavir; its salts  
Oxaliplatin; its salts  
Rituximab  
Zaleplon; its salts";

(ii) by adding –

"Apraclonidine; its salts  
Blood products derived from human blood  
or manufactured by biotechnology, the  
following –

Albumin  
Antithrombins  
Blood clotting factors  
Fibrin  
Fibrinogen  
Plasma protein fractions

Thrombin

Bupivacaine; its salts

Carbimazole; its salts

Dihydroetorphine; its salts

Melitracen; its salts

Mepivacaine; its salts

Methimazole; its salts

Propylthiouracil; its salts

Tiapride; its salts

Tiratricol; its salts

Tretoquinol; its salts

Veralipride; its salts";

- (b) in Part II, in part A, by repealing the item relating to "Pharmaceutical products" and substituting -

"Pharmaceutical products retailed in the form as supplied by the manufacturer, containing a poison included in part A of Part I of this List, where the proportion of the poison does not exceed the equivalent of -

- (a) 0.01% by weight of arsenic trioxide, cantharidin, cocaine, coniine, ecgonine, hydrocyanic acid, strychnine, alkaloids of aconite, alkaloids of coca or alkaloids of gelsemium;
- (b) 2%, weight in volume, of mercurochrome when contained in solutions for external use only; and
- (c) 0.1% by weight in the case of other poisons, except pharmaceutical products containing any poison -
- (i) included in the Third Schedule to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.); or
- (ii) in the following list -

Acetyldihydrocodeine; its salts

Alkaloids of belladonna; their salts

Alkaloids of ephedra; their salts

Atropine; its salts

Bambuterol; its salts  
Benzydamine; its salts  
Butropium; its salts  
Codeine; its salts  
Dextromethorphan; its salts

Explanatory Note

This Regulation updates the Schedule to the Poisons List Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.) by –

(a) adding 28 substances to part A of Part I of the Poisons List; and

(b) revising the scope of pharmaceutical products containing poisons which a listed seller of poisons may retail.
