Explanatory Note

This Order amends Schedule 1 to the Organized and Serious Crimes Ordinance (Cap. 455)("the Ordinance") to add certain offences under the Trade Descriptions Ordinance (Cap. 362) and the Copyright Ordinance (Cap. 528). Once added to the Ordinance, such offences will be subject to the provisions of the Ordinance which provide for additional powers of investigation into certain crimes and proceeds of crime, the confiscation of proceeds of crime and related matters.
