

POISONS LIST (AMENDMENT) REGULATION 2000

(Made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board under section
29 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance
(Cap. 138) subject to the approval
of the Legislative Council)

1. Commencement

Section 2(a) shall come into operation on 1 April 2000.

2. The Poisons List

Part A of Part I of the Schedule to the Poisons List
Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.) is amended -

(a) by adding -

"Antisera, antitoxins, immunoglobulins and
vaccines -

(b) directed against the following

Haemophilus influenzae type b
Hepatitis A
Hepatitis B
Herpes simplex
Influenza
Measles
Mumps
Pertussis
Plague
Poliomyelitis
Rabies
Rubella
Tetanus
Typhoid
Varicella
Yellow fever";

(b) by adding -

"Efavirenz; its salts
Fludarabine; its salts
Imiglucerase
Lepirudin; its salts
Miglitol; its salts
Propoxur; its salts
Raltitrexed; its salts
Rizatriptan; its salts
Rofecoxib; its salts
Sibutramine; its salts

Telmisartan; its salts
Zanamivir; its salts".
