Strengthening youth participation in policy decision-making

The Government has been encouraging youth awareness of and participation in social affairs and politics. With a view to engaging more young people across different age groups to participate in public affairs, this Council urges the Government to set up a governmental advisory structure with a majority of its members being young people aged 15 to 24 who are elected directly by all young people in Hong Kong, so as to engage young people directly in policy decision-making processes and enable young people to voice and influence on important government policies.
