**First meeting of the Sixth Legislative Council**  
**Wednesday 12 October 2016**

Further to the notice of and the preliminary Agenda for the first meeting of the Sixth Legislative Council (“LegCo”) issued under LC Paper No. CB(3) 11/16-17 on 4 October 2016, I attach the Agenda for the meeting of 12 October 2016.

2. Members are invited to note the following arrangements:
- (1) Members should take their seats in the Chamber of the LegCo Complex at 10:55 am;
  - (2) the meeting will start with the taking of the LegCo Oath. The order for Members to take the Oath is set out on the Agenda. The Clerk to LegCo will administer the Oath. Except the Member who is taking the Oath and the next Member waiting to take the Oath, other Members will remain seated. The points to note for oath-taking by Members is attached for Members’ reference;
  - (3) after Members have taken the Oath, the Clerk will, in accordance with paragraphs 6 and 7 of the procedure for the election of the President as set out in Schedule 1 to the Rules of Procedure, invite Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung to preside at the election;

- (4) Members should indicate their choice of candidate by marking on the ballot paper by way of a chop with a “✓” in the box opposite the name of the candidate. The vote indicated on each ballot paper will be read out aloud during the process of counting ballot papers;
- (5) after the President has been elected, Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung will invite the President to take the chair. The President may address the Council, if he so wishes; and
- (6) the President will announce the date and time of the next meeting and adjourn the Council.

## Council meeting of 12 October 2016

### Points to note for oath-taking by Members

#### Taking of Legislative Council Oath

- (1) Members of the Sixth Legislative Council will take the oath at the first meeting of the Legislative Council on Wednesday 12 October 2016 at 11:00 am.
- (2) The **order of oath-taking** of Members has been set out on the Agenda and is now reproduced in **Appendix I** for easy reference.
- (3) Oath-taking will be administered by the Clerk to the Legislative Council.
- (4) Except the Member who is taking the oath and the next Member to take the oath, all Members will remain seated throughout the oath-taking process.
- (5) The procedure for oath-taking is as follows:
  - (a) After the Clerk to the Legislative Council has read out the name of the first Member to take the oath, the Member shall take the oath at the oath-taking table (the oath-taking position is marked with “▲” in **Appendix II**);
  - (b) When the Member who is going to take the oath reaches the oath-taking table, the next Member to take the oath shall be escorted by a steward to the nearest aisle. Three waiting positions are shown in **Appendix II** (marked with “●” of three different colours). Members sitting in the blue zone should stand and wait at the waiting position in the blue zone; Members in the purple zone should wait at the waiting position in the purple zone; and Members in the orange zone should wait at the waiting position in the orange zone;

- (c) Any Member who is late to take the oath in the order set out on the Agenda **shall only take the oath after the Member taking the oath has completed his/her oath-taking.** The precedence of the Members concerned will be adjusted in accordance with the actual order of oath-taking;
- (d) Members shall take the oath in the form and manner prescribed by the Oaths and Declarations Ordinance (Cap. 11), which include **reading out all the words of the Legislative Council Oath prescribed by the law.** The Oath or Affirmation prepared by the Secretariat for each Member will be placed on the oath-taking lectern when the Member concerned is taking the oath;
- (e) Members who have selected an Oath and indicated that the version of “**Almighty God**” will be adopted for oath-taking shall **hold the Bible placed on the oath-taking lectern in his uplifted hand** while taking the oath; and
- (f) After taking the oath, Members shall **sign** on the Oath or Affirmation, and **leave the document on the oath-taking lectern** (instead of handing it over to the oath administrator or staff), and **return** to their seats **by the original route.**

The election of the President will be conducted immediately after the oath-taking ceremony. After the elected President has adjourned the Council, Members will please remain in the Chamber for taking group photos.

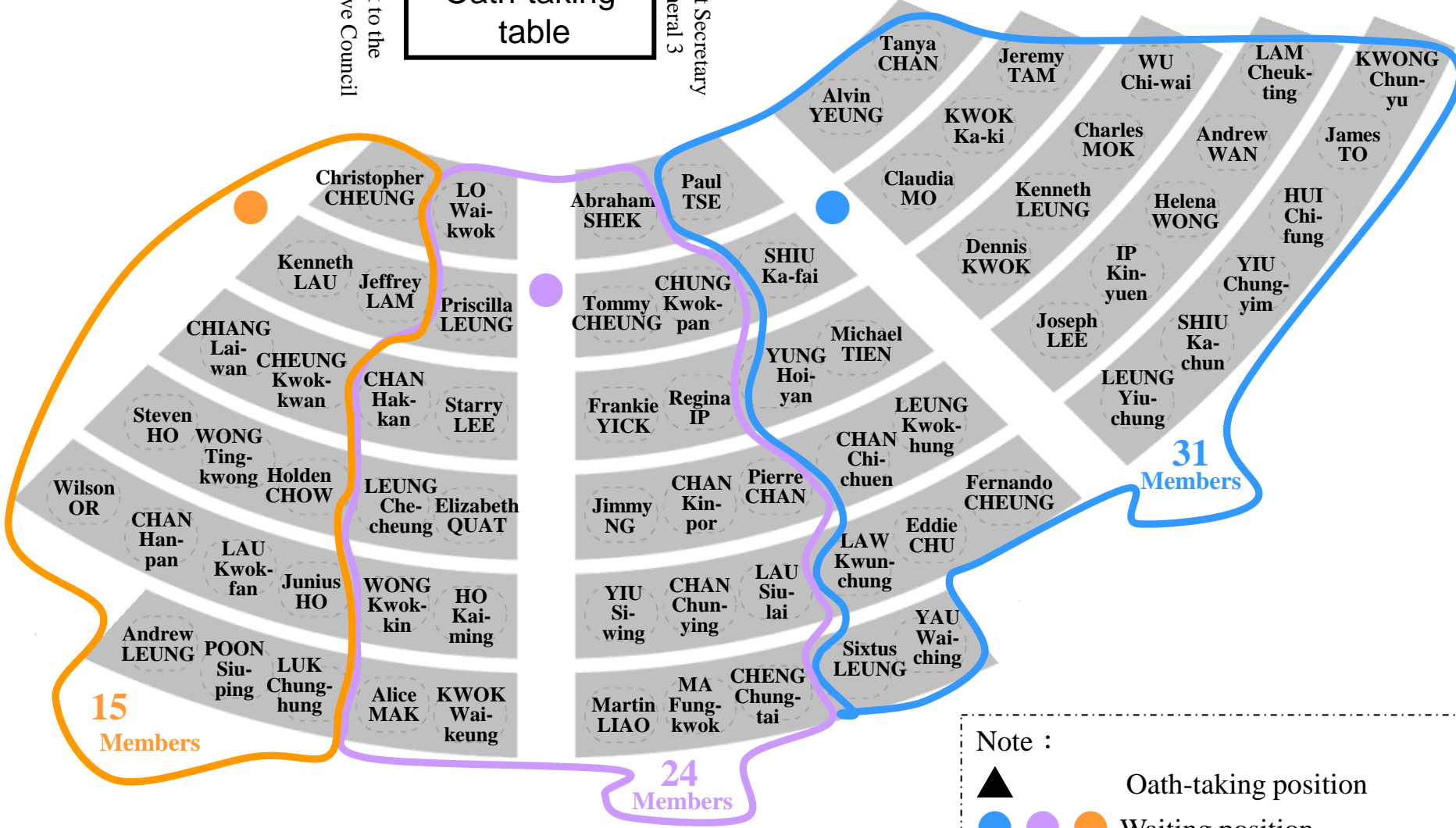
