Preventive measures for COVID-19 implemented by the Legislative Council Secretariat (Updated on 30 July 2020)

In view of the latest situation of the COVID-19 epidemic, the Legislative Council ("LegCo") Secretariat ("Secretariat") will arrange staff to continue to work from home, except those who are responsible for maintaining basic operation of the Secretariat and those performing on-site duties. In addition, the Secretariat will continue to implement the following epidemic prevention measures:

- (a) Footbridge Entrance, Members' Entrance 2 and entrance to the three-lift lobby at LG1 will be closed;
- (b) Public Entrance 2 and entrance to the four-lift lobby at LG1 will be open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm from Monday to Sunday;
- (c) on-site services of the LegCo Library and the Archives will be suspended, but enquiry services will be provided; and
- (d) counter services of the Public Complaints Office will be suspended.
- 2. The following arrangements will continue to apply:
- (a) all persons who are subject to compulsory quarantine will be denied entry into the LegCo Complex ("the Complex"). All Secretariat staff, others who work at the Complex and visitors who have had close contact with initially confirmed cases and confirmed cases of COVID-19 or persons who are subject to compulsory quarantine, will also be denied entry into the Complex;
- (b) all persons entering the Complex are subject to body temperature screening. Any persons who refuse to undergo body temperature screening or whose body temperature is higher than 37.5°C may be denied entry into the Complex;
- (c) the Complex is closed from 8:00 pm each day to 7:00 am the following day. All Complex users must leave by 8:00 pm;
- (d) the facilities of the Complex will be cleaned and disinfected more frequently;
- (e) all persons entering the Complex are required to walk on the disinfectant floor mat at the entrance before entry;
- (f) hand sanitizers are provided at the reception counters, pantries and toilets; and
- (g) the LegCo Cafeteria remains open but will implement the requirements applicable to catering premises.

3. Complex users are strongly advised to maintain good personal hygiene (including wearing surgical masks and performing hand hygiene at all times), minimize the number of people gathering when conducting any activities inside the Complex, and keep abreast of the latest health information disseminated by the Centre for Health Protection:
