## Guangdong's regulation of food exports to Hong Kong

## 1. Background

- 1.1 In the Mainland, the State General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine (國家質量監督 檢驗檢疫總局) ("AQSIQ") is a ministerial administrative body established under the State Council (國務院) tasked with, among other things, overseeing the safety of exported food. AQSIQ has set up 35 entry-exit inspection and quarantine bureaux in various provinces for administering the relevant food export legislation and regulations. In Guangdong, there are three AQSIQ entry-exit inspection and quarantine bureaux responsible for regulation of food such as vegetables, live poultry, livestock and aquatic products exported to Hong Kong.
- 1.2 As to food export legislation, the *Food Safety Law of the People's Republic of China*《中華人民共和國食品 安全法》is the overarching legislation covering areas such as safety of exported food, monitoring and assessment of food safety risks, food safety standards and food inspection. Other relevant legislation includes the *Law of the People's Republic of China on the Entry and Exit Animal and Plant Quarantine*《中華人民共和國進出境動植物檢疫法》, the *Law of the People's Republic of China on Import and Export Commodity Inspection*《中華人民共和國進出口商品檢驗法》and related regulations.

The responsibilities of AQSIQ include entry-exit health quarantine, entry-exit commodity inspection, entry-exit quarantine of animals and plants, safety of imported and exported food, and certification and accreditation.

These are the Guangdong, Shenzhen and Zhuhai Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Bureaux.

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1.3 In addition to the national legislation, AQSIQ has also put in place various administrative measures regulating the supply of specified categories of food to Hong Kong. These administrative measures provide for the registration of farms and related establishments supplying food to Hong Kong, the control and supervision of the registered establishments, and the related inspection and quarantine arrangements. The entry-exit inspection and quarantine bureaux in Guangdong are responsible for implementing the respective administrative measures, and the relevant provisions governing the export of vegetables, live poultry, livestock (pigs, cattle and goats) and aquatic products to Hong Kong are highlighted in the **Table** below.
