List of follow-up actions arising from discussion at the meeting on 4 May 2001

- (1) To seek the Law Society of Hong Kong (LS)'s views on the Administration's response to its submission dated 12 April 2001.
- (2) To provide the list of certified documents which are considered registrable by LS and the rationale for the Administration to accept or decline to accept registration of these documents.
- (3) To re-consider the provision for destroying or otherwise disposing of copies of plans after they have been recorded by the imaging method.
- (4) To refine the drafting of clause 4(63) in respect of an individual signing the instrument.
- (5) To revert back to members the measures to safeguard against trespassing and unauthorized amendments to entries of the Central Registration System after these have been worked out.
- (6) To seek legal advice on whether an application against a decision of the Land Registrar to withhold registration could be submitted by way of summons in Chamber in addition to originating summons and petition.
