 - (b) Section 2.3.2 (a) whether working experience in lieu of academic qualification could be considered for qualifying purpose.
 - (c) Section 2.3.2(c)

whether the requirement of no previous conviction record of careless driving could be relaxed to allow persons with such previous conviction years ago to qualify as course instructors.

(d) <u>Section 2.4.8</u>

whether a deadline for the application of discontinuation of attendance at the driving improvement school after the first session could be specified.

(e) <u>Sections 2.4.10 and 2.4.11</u>

whether there was a need to provide driving training courses in different languages and whether the present drafting of the relevant sections were consistent with the human rights provisions of the Basic Law.

(f) Section 4.4

whether an objective evaluation mechanism to assess the performance of the participants could be introduced and whether an appeal channel could be provided to avoid abuse.

(g) <u>Section 5.2(b)</u>

whether there was a need for the proprietor of a driving improvement school to submit the requested information, taking into account the administrative work incurred by the proprietor.

(h) Section 5.3(b)

whether a detailed working mechanism for the Commissioner for Transport to deal with complaint and appeal cases lodged by participants of driving improvement scheme could be set out in the code of practice.

- Admin 4. The Administration undertook to consider members' views and consult the trade. The results would be reported to the LegCo Panel on Transport through an Information Note.
