3. <u>Members</u> requested the Administration to consider the following issues and provide further information to facilitate their consideration:

#### (a) <u>Double penalty on driving offence</u>

<u>Members</u> were concerned about the possible double penalty imposed by the court on the same breach of a driving offence under the new section 72A. They requested the Administration to review the Action

flexibility granted to the court in this regard with reference to the intent of introducing a Driver Improvement Scheme (DIS), the seriousness of the committed driving offence and the practices in other overseas countries.

#### (b) <u>Determination of maximum fees for a driving improvement course</u>

Members were concerned that the maximum fee of \$1,000 for a driving improvement course was too high. They requested the Administration to consider introducing a mechanism to enable the Legislative Council to regulate the adjustment of maximum fees for a driving improvement course. They also requested the Administration to provide information on fees charged by overseas counterparts on similar courses.

#### (c) Eligibility criteria for the DIS

The <u>Chairman</u> requested the Administration to consider restricting the eligibility criteria for the DIS to drivers with a driving-offence points (DOP) balance of 10 points or less. He also requested the Administration to provide information on the eligible DOP balance threshold for attending DIS course in other overseas countries.

- 4. At the request of Mrs Miriam LAU, the <u>Administration</u> undertook to hold briefing sessions for the relevant industry on the requirements for operating driving improvement courses.
- 5. The <u>Committee</u> agreed to hold a meeting on 9 November 2001 at 8:30 am to receive public views on the Bill and to continue discussion with the Administration.
