 - The Administration to consider redrafting the new section 72A on the (a) penalty options open to the court, taking into account the possibility of double penalty on minor driving offences, and the flexibility granted to the court to direct a person to attend a driving improvement course for certain offences in lieu of other penalties as adopted by Saskatchewan, Canada and the State of California, USA;
 - (b) The Administration to provide the definitions of "serious traffic violation" as defined in Section 15210(i) of the Vehicle Code of the State of California, USA: and
 - (c) The Administration to consider whether the offence of failure to attend and complete a driving improvement course as provided for under the new section 72A(8) warrants an imprisonment penalty.
