- (1) To report to the Panel on Housing outcome of the study on the feasibility of vesting the Rating and Valuation Department with the power to deal with tenancy disputes not exceeding a prescribed amount of money.
- (2) To include the distress procedures in the comprehensive review of the security of tenure provisions of the Landlord and Tenant (Consolidation) Ordinance (Cap. 7).
- (3) To provide the revised internal guidelines on the handling of tenancy disputes by the Police.
- (4) To introduce Committee Stage amendment to revise the Notice of Application under the Landlord and Tenant (Consolidation) Ordinance (Form 22).
- (5) To review the drafting of proposed sections 117(3) of clause 11, 119F(2)(a), 119F(4)(d) and 119F(5)(ba) of clause 18 and section 69(3) of the District Court Ordinance (Cap. 336) of the Schedule.
