Bills Committee on Public Health and Municipal Services (Amendment) Bill 2001

On behalf of Hon Fred LI Wah-ming, Chairman of the Bills Committee, I write to invite representatives of the Administration to the next meeting of the Bills Committee scheduled for **Friday**, 6 **July 2001 at 8:30 am in Conference Room A of the Legislative Council Building**.
