I. Meeting with the Administration

(LC Paper Nos. CB(2)2757/03-04(01) and CB(2)2792/03-04(01))

<u>The Bills Committee</u> deliberated (Index of proceedings at **Annex**).

- 2. <u>Mrs Sophie LEUNG</u> said that a new provision should be added to the Human Organ Transplant Ordinance (the Ordinance) setting out clearly the functions and purview of the Human Organ Transplant Board to avoid misunderstanding of what the Board was empowered to do. <u>The Administration</u> agreed, and would move Committee Stage amendment (CSA) along the lines suggested by Mrs LEUNG.
- 3. As the Administration would not move CSAs to put it beyond doubt in the Ordinance that same sex marriage recognised by law or by court overseas and domestic partnerships registered overseas should be treated in the same manner as the marital relationship referred to in the proposed section 5A(1)(a)(ii), Ms Cyd HO said that she might move her own CSAs to that effect.
- 4. <u>Members</u> did not raise any objection to the proposed CSAs to be moved by the Administration set out in LC Paper No. CB(2)2757/03-04(01).
- 5. <u>Members</u> agreed to submit a report to the House Committee on 18 June 2004 recommending the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill at the Council meeting on 7 July 2004. The deadline for giving notice to move CSAs was 26 June 2004.

6. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 6:00 pm.
