Supplementary Information on 236WF – Mainlaying between Kam Tin Shi and Route Twisk Roundabout

INTRODUCTION

When Members considered paper PWSC(2000-01)77 on **236WF** “Mainlaying between Kam Tin Shi and Route Twisk Roundabout” at the Public Works Subcommittee meeting on 10 January 2001, the Administration undertook to confirm whether the population figures as set out in paragraph 6 of the paper, concerning the projected demand of fresh water supply for existing and planned developments, had taken into account all the planned developments in Au Tau and Kam Tin area.

THE ADMINISTRATION’S RESPONSE

2. We confirm that the population figures as stated in paragraph 6 of PWSC(2000-01)77 have taken into account the estimated natural growth of population in existing villages and all the anticipated, committed and planned developments in the areas, such as the potential residential developments at Sha Po, Ko Po Tsuen, Kam Tin Shi, Shek Wu Tong, Pang Ka Tsuen and Kiu Tau Tsuen.
