Supplementary Information on 184SC - Community Hall at Lei Muk Shue Estate, phase 4

INTRODUCTION

When Members considered paper PWSC(2001-02)12 on **184SC** - Community hall at Lei Muk Shue Estate, phase 4 at the PWSC meeting on 18 April 2001, the Administration undertook to provide comparative information on the construction cost of community halls (CHs) in other housing estates.

THE ADMINISTRATION'S RESPONSE

- 2. The table at Enclosure 1 compares the construction costs of CHs in four other housing developments, namely, Aldrich Bay phase 4, Tsz On Estate phase 3, Sheung Tak Estate phase 9 and Shek Lei Estate phase 12. Funding for these four projects was approved by the Finance Committee in July 1999.
- 3. The schedules of accommodation for all five CHs are very similar although the net operational floor area (NOFA) of the CH at Lei Muk Shue is larger because of the addition of an extra study room and an extra function room.
- 4. Through adopting a more efficient and compact design, however, the superstructure cost (building and building services costs) per NOFA for the project at Lei Muk Shue Estate is lower than that of the other projects.
