Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) Designation of Libraries (No. 2) Order 2001 (L.N. 138)

By this Order made under section 105K of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132), the Director of Leisure and Cultural Services has designated 9 Wan Lung Road, Tseung Kwan O ("the Library") as a library. Simultaneously in this Order, the Schedule to the Designation of Libraries Order (Cap.132 sub. leg.) is amended by adding the Library as item 61.

The drafting and legal aspects of the subsidiary legislation are in order.

Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132)
Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Public Markets) (Designation and Amendment of Tenth Schedule) (No. 2) Order 2001 (L.N. 139)

By this Order made under section 79(5) of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) ("the Ordinance"), the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene has cancelled the designation of Chai Wan Temporary Market and Lee Chung Street Cooked Food Market ("the Markets") as public markets. This Order simultaneously amends the Tenth Schedule to the Ordinance by repealing the

reference to the Markets.

The drafting and legal aspects of the subsidiary legislation are in order.

Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132)

Declaration of Markets Notice (Amendment) (No. 2) Declaration 2001
(L.N. 140)

By this Declaration made under section 79(1) of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) ("the Ordinance"), the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene has declared that Chai Wan Temporary Market and Lee Chung Street Cooked Food Market ("the Markets") shall cease to be markets to which the Ordinance applies. This Declaration simultaneously amends the Schedule to the Declaration of Markets Notice (Cap. 132 sub. leg.) by repealing the reference to the Markets.
