Antiquities and Monuments Ordinance (Cap. 53)
Antiquities and Monuments (Declaration of Historical Buildings) (No. 2) Notice 2000 (L.N. 368)

Under section 3(1) of the Antiquities and Monuments Ordinance (Cap. 53), the Secretary for Home Affairs may, after consultation with the Antiquities Advisory Board and with the approval of the Chief Executive, by notice in the Gazette, declare any building which the Secretary for Home Affairs considers to be of public interest by reason of its historical significance, to be a historical building.

This Notice declares the following buildings be historical buildings -

- (a) the Waglan Lighthouse on Waglan Island, Hong Kong, and the adjacent land; and
- (b) the Tang Lung Chau Lighthouse, commonly known as Kap Sing Lighthouse, and the former light keeper's house on Tang Lung Chau, Kap Shui Mun, Hong Kong.

The effect of this Notice is that as from the date of Gazettal, i.e. from 29 December 2000 onwards, no person shall excavate, carry on building or other works, demolish or, interfere with these two buildings except in accordance with a permit granted by the Secretary for Home Affairs.

The legal and drafting aspects of this Notice are in order.
