Re: Legal Services and Risk to Justice

I am a sole legal practitioner in Hong Kong and would like to address to you a serious danger to the equality of justice, taking into account to what recently happened in the legal profession.

Every solicitor in private practice is required to pay annual insurance premium under the present Professional Indemnity Scheme in order to cover any risk of loss to the clients from malpractice of the practitioners. However, a recent proposed substantial increase in the amount of insurance premium to about 260% will certainly bring forth a danger to the achievement of justice in Hong Kong.

There are totally about six hundred law firms in Hong Kong but over 80% of them are sole practitioners and firms of small and middle size. They provide legal services to the individuals and small organizations of the general public. The drastic increase in such premium amount will impose severe cost burden on these small firms and possibly drive them out from the local market. What will happen then? Only the giants will remain in the legal jungle and they represent all those big corporations and strong persons. In such circumstances, justice will exist in vacuum.

In view of this serious danger to the whole society, I have contacted a number of small law firms and they have given their affirmative support to my address. A list of the supporting law firms is attached herewith for your reference.

I therefore have written a letter of address to the Chief Executive for his urgent attention. A copy of the letter is enclosed herewith for your information. I hereby also request the Councilor to pay urgent attention to this matter and take appropriate action as necessary to avoid this potential danger to the society at large since the subsidiary legislation for increasing the premium will soon be implemented.
