## LegCo Panel on Constitutional Affairs Meeting on 7 May 2001

## **Application of Prevention of Bribery Provisions to the Chief Executive**

Thank you for your letter of 12 April 2001 enclosing the agenda for the above Panel meeting. For the purpose of agenda item (VI), I enclose a copy of an information paper for your distribution to Members.

With reference to Member's request for information on previous prosecutions taken against Government officers (paragraph 7 of the minutes of the LegCo Panel on Constitutional Affairs meeting on 20 November 2001 refers), please be advised that –

- (a) On previous prosecutions taken against Government officers for possession of unexplained property acquired before section 10 of the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance (POBO) came into force, available records indicate that there have been nine prosecutions for offences in contravention of section 10(1)(b) of the POBO in which the assets concerned were acquired before the enactment of the POBO in 1971.
- (b) Available records indicate that no prosecution has ever been taken against Government officers for the common law offence of bribery. The major reason being that Government officers would be caught by the provisions of the POBO since its enactment in 1971.
