Postage Revision

At the meeting on 28 May 2001 to discuss Postage Revision, some Members requested the Administration to provide supplementary information on the following -

- (a) Unit cost and percentage of recovery for major mail categories;
- (b) Comparison of domestic postage rates in Hong Kong and overseas countries; and
- (c) Traffic and revenue from the Printed Papers service as percentage of the total traffic and revenue from local mail.

The information is herewith enclosed as Annexes A to C respectively.

Regarding **Annex A**, Members may wish to note that for local mail, which represents over 80% of the total mail traffic handled, the Post Office is not achieving full cost recovery. This will continue even after

the planned postage revision. In the light of decreasing revenue from profitable services such as airmail and philatelic services, and to avoid subsidising overseas mailers, there is a need to bring local postage rates more in line with cost recovery.

Regarding **Annex B**, Members may wish to note that, while Hongkong Post continues to provide high quality service, our domestic postage rates at almost all levels are generally lower or in line with postage rates of various overseas countries.

Regarding Annex C, Members may wish to note that local printed papers service only constituted around 13% and 16% of overall local mail traffic and revenue respectively, and that the demand for the service is decreasing year after year. The abolition of local printed papers service is a response to the Public Accounts Committee's recommendation in 1993 that the Postmaster General should review the price structure and service standard of this service, as the Director of Audit's has questioned the justification for preferential rates for printed papers. After the abolition, letter rates will apply to printed papers. Whether there will be increase or reduction in mailing cost would depend on the choice of service quality and the weight of the item. The Post Office will continue to provide the same discount levels currently available for pre-sorted mail and bulk postings of first class and economy items.
